WHEREAS, the Heritage Pines Community Development District ("District") is a local unit of special-purpose government created by, and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, and situated entirely within Pasco County, Florida; and

SECTION 1. ADOPTING REGULAR MEETING SCHEDULE. Regular meetings of the District's Board shall be held during Fiscal Year 2023/2024 as provided on the schedule attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. FILING REQUIREMENT. In accordance with Section 189.015(1), Florida Statutes, the District's Secretary is hereby directed to file a schedule of the District's regular meetings annually with Pasco County and the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

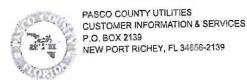

Item 3, Line 5: Change "five (5)" to "twenty (20)"

Discussion ensued regarding the requirement for an addendum to the Agreement for additional services, what it applies to and how it will be implemented.

Regarding the scope of work, Ms. Lonergan stated that all the changes requested were not addressed. Others believed that requested changes were incorporated into the scope.

Discussion ensued regarding whether it is necessary to include wording requiring a proposal or if it is understood that the proposal will be an exhibit to the addendum.
